Sue Room Jan Kilcoyne Les Miller

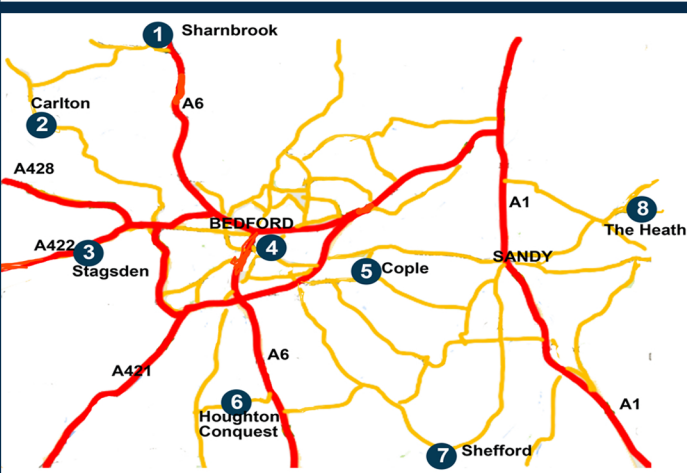
